

Riley's Way Youth Leadership Retreat 2022 COVID Policy

In order to optimize health and safety for all participants and staff, Riley's Way Foundation has set the following policies in place for the 2022 Youth Leadership Retreat. We will continue to monitor and adapt these guidelines based on the latest CDC recommendations.

Prior to the Retreat:

1. All participants, Team Mentors, chaperones, guest speakers, and staff must be fully vaccinated for COVID-19 in order to attend the Retreat.
2. Proof of vaccination must be submitted to Riley's Way Foundation before travel arrangements will be made for any Retreat participants.
3. All participants will be required to take a rapid COVID test the morning they depart for the Retreat, and will be asked to show proof of a negative result.
4. We ask that all participants taking an airplane or train wear a mask during travel.

During the Retreat:

1. All participants will be asked to take a rapid COVID test upon arrival.
 - a. If a participant's rapid test is positive, they will be placed into quarantine until their parent/guardian can pick them up or other arrangements can be made.
 - b. Parent/guardian agrees to have their child picked up at the Retreat as soon as possible if they test positive for COVID. **Parent/guardian initial here** _____
